## A MARRIAGE OF TASTE

Palace Court is not your usual London apartment. The luxurious lateral penthouse comprises of three apartments joined into one, all with large windows with stunning views towards Hyde Park. Roselind Wilson Design was approached by the client to transform the rather bland, whitewashed apartment into an elegant, chic and sophisticated residence suitable for three generations of his family. They were tasked to harmoniously marry the family's varied design tastes to deliver a truly unique and individual apartment. The brief specified a central entertainment area, including the living room, dining room, kitchen, utility room and guest WC. Within the apartment, there are also two wings, which the client had particular specifications for. The left wing was to allow for the media and wine room, bedrooms, and ensuite family bathrooms, as well as a room specifically designed as a sleeping and bathing room for the family pooch. The right wing of the property was to include a gentleman's study, and a master suite comprising master bedroom and ensuite, his and her dressing rooms and a fur room.
