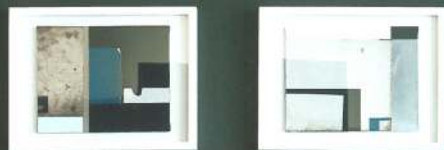

# Kitchen CABINETRY

## Boxing clever

An island unit formed from two stacked coffee tables and shelving made from upturned side tables give this classic Shaker-style kitchen by Neptune an up-to-date twist. Designer Fred Horlock describes the look as 'industrial evolves into elegance', adding reclaimed wood, Black Peppercorn granite surfaces and black cup handles. 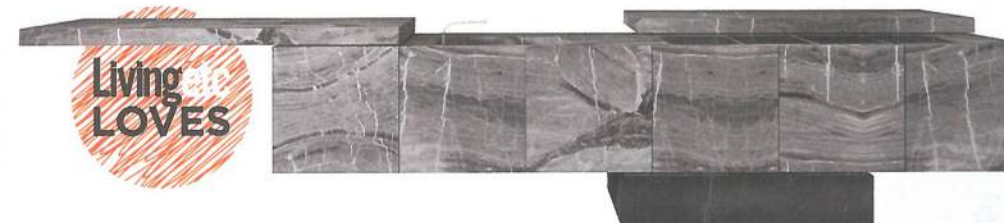


## Pure elegance

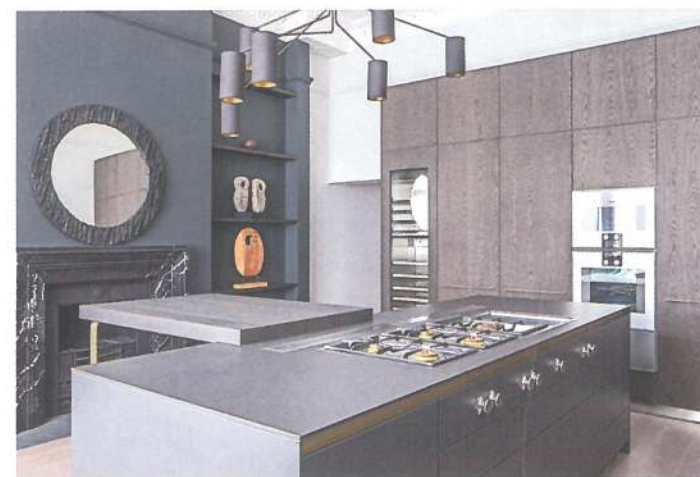
