



Mews house has a green kitchen wall

A backlit fake living wall, providing a touch of green space in a window-less room, is a fascinating feature of the basement kitchen diner at a totally refurbished house in Belcravia.

The basement of the 1675 sq ft property in Eaton Mews North also has a hidden dumb waiter for speedy delivery of meals and drinks from the kitchen to the first floor living area, avoiding two flights of stairs.

The developer of the mews house behind exclusive Eaton, Square contacted Roselind Wilson Design in 2012 to reconfigure the property and design the interior. Werks began in 2012 and were completed in July this year.

Previously the home was arranged across a ground and first floor reception, living area and kitchen and a second floor with two bedrooms and two bathrooms. Designer Roselind Wilson said: "RWD was appointed to carry out the full interior architectural specification, which included reviewing the layouts and determining a new layout across four floors: basement, ground, first and second."

On the ground floor, the guest bedroom has an en suite bathroom and the large entrance hall has fitted cupboards to store coats and shoes. On the first floor is an open plan sitting room with a wall of bespoke shelving lit by LEDs. A writing desk - with neon artwork above - and contemporary stools are at the opposite

end of the living area.

RWD's reconfiguration created more space and luxury for the master bedroom with marble bathroom on the second floor. A garage is big enough for a Range Rover Sport and there's extra parking outside.
