TIMELESS MODERNITY

Cornwall House is a new build multi storey residential apartment building situated close to Regents Park, London. Working alongside the architects, Roselind Wilson Design was appointed to design the interior space of the apartment to portray a sense of luxury and affluent living to a tight budget and installation deadline. The interior design scheme comprised of a soft neutral palette of creams and beige, offset by dark chocolate timbers and accents of blue and gold in the open plan living space. The remainder of the apartment continues along the line of the soft palette with an accent of gold throughout. The palette and proportions of the furniture were all carefully considered so as not to be overbearing. The scheme enhances the features and creates a space, which is modern yet timeless.
